
# Types of Courses in NEP2020





➤ The Semester Grade Point Average (SGPA) is computed from the grades as a measure of the performance in a given semester.

Letter Grade	Grade Point	% of Marks Obtained
O (outstanding)	10	Above 90%
A+ (Excellent)	9	Above 80% to 90%
A (Very good)	8	Above 70% to 80%
B+ (Good)	7	Above 60% to 70%
B (Above average)	6	Above 50% to 60%
C (Average)	5	Above 40% to 50%
P (Pass)	4	40%
F (Fail)	0	Below 40%
Ab (Absent)	0	Absent
